I. INTRODUCTION-

The surface of the lip is comprised of four zones:

- a. Hairy skin
- b. Vermillion border
- c. Vermillion
- d. Oral mucosa

The vermillion of the lip is comprised of a modified composed of hairless, highly

vascularized, nonkeratinized stratified squamous epithelium. This membrane is three to five cellular layers in thickness, in contrast to the 16-layer facial skin. Lips that are chapped, dry, or cracked are a relatively frequent cosmetic problem, especially in winter season.

The majority of people currently have dry lips s a result of their country's cold and dry weather. Moreover, being dehydrated also causes chapped lips or dry lips in an individual. Additionally, according to Beeter Health Channel, 30% of the general population suffers from dry mouths, which indicates that these people are affected by lip damage issue.

II. MAKING POWER OF MINT LEAVES AND BEETROOT FRUIT-

Firstly, wash mint leaves and beetroot fruit, then peel off beetroot and grate it.

Dry mint leaves and grated beetroot at room temperature for around 2-3 days.

After drying, grind both ingredients individually and make powder.

- 5. Firstly, Honey is mixed with sugar in porcelain dish.

- 6. Add beetroot powder in it respectively.
- 7. Continuously stir, in between add mint powder and quality sufficient water.

Skin irritation Test-


It was determined by apply scrub on the skin for 5 min
